

# Faithfull (FAIHGP) Geologists Pick 624g (22oz)

This Faithfull geologist's hammer or geological pick is used for splitting and breaking rocks. In field geology, they are used to obtain a fresh surface of a rock in order to determine its composition, nature, mineralogy, history, and field estimate of rock strength. In fossil collecting, they are employed to break rocks with the aim of revealing fossils inside. Used by geologists for taking samples in the field. This pick has one large square striking face and the other end is ground to a point for splitting, cracking, and levering.
