INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE IN THE CASE OF CHOKING

If a casualty is a victim of choking

- 1 Encourage the victim to cough.
- 2 If the cough is not effective, call Emergency Services and give 5 Back Slaps.
- 3 If obstruction has not been cleared, follow by 5 Abdominal Thrusts.



Instructions For Use

IF THE VICTIM IS CHOKING, IF NOT EFFECTIVE GIVE THE EMERGENCY SERVICES AND FOLLOW BY 5 BACK SLAPS AND 5 ABDOMINAL THRUSTS. IF THE VICTIM IS UNCONSCIOUS, OR IF BOTH AND NOSE BLOOD AND WITH A HAND APPLIED, USE LIFEVAC. MAKE SURE TO CHECK THE MOUTH & PLACE IT BEHIND THE VICTIM'S HEAD.

1. Unplug mouthpiece and place mask over nose and mouth. Make sure to check the mask is placed firmly to the victim's face.
2. For head down, place tip of nose on the bridge of the nose. Between the arms, between the chest and the back, tip of mask should be in contact between chest and back. If needed, use your own hand to hold the mask. Make sure the head is held firmly and the mask is placed over the mouth and nose.
3. Pressing mask firmly against with one hand, place your other hand on the forehead and your push handle down to compress the mask.
4. When victims are unconscious, pull forward the mask and place your hand on the forehead and your push handle down to compress the mask.
5. Roll yourself into your side and away from the victim. Repeat steps up to 5 times if necessary.

IF NO SPONTANEOUS RESPIRATION IS NOTED, THE FOLLOWING STEPS SHOULD BE FOLLOWED TO PROVIDE LIFE SUPPORT (CPR) IMMEDIATELY.
