






#### A FEW DETAILS ABOUT THE STANDARD EN 381-5: REQUIREMENTS FOR LEG PROTECTORS

#### • 3 types of areas of protection: A, B, and C







Class 3: 28 m/s

• 3 test speeds which correspond to the following classes:

Class 1: 20 m/s

Protection can be achieved by using several operating procedures, such as:

a) sliding of the chain: on contact, the chain does not cut the material

b) stuffing: fibres are dragged along by the chain towards the pinion, and come to block the movement of the chain

Class 2: 24 m/s

c) braking of the chain: fibres have great resistance to being cut, and absorb the rotation energy, thus slowing down the speed of the chain. Often, more than one of these principles are applied simultaneously.

Maintenance of clothes: regular maintenance of clothes allows the protective system to be effective.
